Which theme, as listed in the Longfonds Requirements, does your research align with? Does your research contribute to existing knowledge gaps and/or the knowledge agenda? If so, please describe in what way. (max. 300 words)

**6) Scientific and Societal Impact**

Describe the scientific and societal impact of the project (min. 300 - max. 500 words).

**7) Proposed Project Budget**

Provide a proposed project budget and briefly justify the requested amount.

**8) International Reviewers List**

Provide a list of 7 potential international reviewers.
