3) Innovative characteristics

Provide a bullet-point overview of the innovative characteristics and the potential for follow-up research and its foreseen societal impact and/or relevance for patients.

4) Theme/knowledge gaps (see Requirements document)

Which theme (prevention, early diagnosis, treatment, cure or other) does your exploratory study align with? Please describe in what way. (max. 300 words).

5) Proposed project budget (max. €50,000)

Provide a proposed project budget and briefly justify the requested amount. Justify the amount and specify if co-funding is involved.
