

Application Form Sterk Participatieprijs 2026 | Sterk Participation Award 2026

Researchers are once again invited to apply for the Sterk Participation Award. This award is intended for researchers who have explicitly integrated patient participation into their research project.

The Sterk Participation Award amounts to €5,000. Of this, €500 is intended as recognition of the researcher's commitment to patient participation and may be spent at the winner's discretion. The remaining €4,500 is to be used for activities that strengthen patient participation (see Award Conditions).

To be eligible for the Sterk Participation Award, the researcher must submit an abstract to the Dutch Lung Congress (deadline 31st October) <u>AND</u> answer five additional questions on the Participatieprijs Application Form. Deadline for the submission of this form is November 15th, 12:00 (noon). Please find additional information in the Requirements document.

Abstracts and responses will be reviewed by a selection committee consisting of a representative from the scientific lung research field, Experts by Experience (people living with a lung disease), and the Research Manager of Longfonds (Lung Foundation Netherlands).
